When we see the goodness of God's Will, which is the Holy City, the kingdom of the government of God, we are filled with the faith, hope and love that are in Jesus, producing obedience, joy, praise and witnessing in and through us daily.

When we read Revelation, we would see Jesus Christ introduced to us in different ways. As (1) The King of Glory, (2) The Head of the Church, (3) The Man of God, (4) the Lion of Judah, (5) The Lamb of God, (6) Ruler of the kings of the earth, (7) Mediator of the New Covenant, (8) the Man of War, (9) the King of Zion, (10) the Lord of the Harvest, (11) the Lord of the Clouds/victory, (12) Lord of the dimensions, (13) Judge of the worlds, (14) the Deliverer, (15) the Marriage, King of kings, (16) Head of Christ, Lord of the Millennium, (17) God of gods.

“When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.” John 16:13-14,

Now, in the process of learning to love the Lord, and loving obedience, we always need the vision of reality in the midst of so much corruption and rebellion and sin.

This bride is the one who loves the Lord, there's a sweet, and saintly submission to the Lord, in alignment to the actions of the Lord, but more so, to the Spirit of the Lord.

This is why we read **“The Spirit and the Bride say, “Come.” And let the one who hears say, “Come.” And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price”**

Revelation 22:17, Jesus is saying He is the Bridegroom, He is the Husband of the bride, being the root and descendant of David, the bright morning star!

The Bride knows the Lord Glorified, the Head of the church, the Lamb of God, the Son of God, the Man of God, the Man of War, the Lord of the Harvest, the Lord of Host, the Word of God, the King of kings and Lord of Lords, and the Bridegroom. This is what it means to love the Lord, it's to be full of the Lord, for the Lord to be everything to us. We enter the school of these lessons through the revelation of the Holy Spirit, and consecration in these revelations.

This is the journey of soul, being shepherded by Jesus Christ, that happens in the book of revelation. Jesus appeared to John as the glorified one, to prepare him for what he is about to see. Then, Jesus would have him prepare the church, through his letters to them, so that they will all stand on resurrection ground, to be able to ascend. To be able to see Yeshua in His

movements through the church and the world, leading to the completeness of the harvest. Jesus revealed to the churches the implication of the resurrection. (1) It means highest authority, and should be our highest pursuit and highest hope and love. (2) It means full revelation of life, so we shouldn't be afraid of death or suffering. (3) it means the highest battle strategy, the highest victory against Satan, so, we shouldn't look for another battle strategy, neither allow anyone amongst us do that. (4) it means He and the resurrection is the best way to continue in victory and ruling. We started with Jesus, we don't need to continue by another person, we must persevere with Jesus alone, this is how loyalty and reality is developed. (5) it means resurrection is the fullness of the manifest power of God. Many have disconnected from

Jesus and Christ as the only power of God and have begun to look at the works and the reputation. Those who are most concerned about reputation are those who are dead. When we take Jesus as the only power, Jesus will release his angelic activity and sovereignty activity on our behalf. Our works are not complete if they are not done in faith alone, by the power of the Spirit alone (6) the fullness of the kingdom of God. The risen Christ is

the fullness of the kingdom of God, and because of this, we don't have to struggle for dominion amongst men, we only have to receive the resurrection as the fullness of dominion, and Jesus will cause the kingdom of darkness to submit to the kingdom of light. We are to endure with Him as the fullness of the kingdom. When we know this, we would be made leaders too, with crowns and pillars in Zion (7) the resurrection is the end of the flesh, the end of the old creation and the beginning of the new creation. It's entrance into another economy altogether. He is the end of confusion and carnality and duplicity. When we see this, we are really standing on resurrection ground and so, ready to ascend to and fro in the realms of God with John.

This consecration to Jesus, positions us for higher and deeper experiences with Jesus Christ.

The resounding call and prophetic voice of revelation in these times is "Come". In these last days, what the Lord is saying to us is "Come", which means that He is already with us. That's His prophetic word to us.

We read **"He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord**

Jesus!" Revelation 22:20. The Lord our commander in warfare, sent His angel, to John, our fellow soldier in this present warfare (*Revelation 1:9*), to encourage the churches in this present warfare, by causing us to see the certainty of our victory due to His manifest presence, and the certainty of our victory rewards for the warfare.

The book of Revelation is not really to establish who will go to heaven or hell, but to encourage those who are heavenly citizens, who are now in serious battle on the journey, by giving us the map of different milestones on the journey, and all the victory tactics we need to know, and what the victory actually is.

The victory is actually having our commander with us physically. It's having Jesus Christ with us physically. This is our hope, that we would see Him face to face. This is because our commander is also our lover. We want to abide with Him. It pleases our hearts greatly that He is coming. We are those that love His appearing and His power. We fight to stay in love with Him, fighting a thousand distractions, disturbances, lies, ambitions, superficialities and comforts, so that our passion for following Him doesn't reduce.

The major contents of our victory-experience, which is described in this book, is sharing in the tree of life, and sharing in the holy city. **“and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, *God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book*”** Revelation 22:19, this is why we are charged to not despise prophecy, so that we don't miss out on our advantages for intimacy and warfare. We have a share in the tree of life and in the holy city, meaning, we are functioning like a tree of life, a tree that is living by eternal life and supplying life to others, and supplying fruits. Also, we are called to live like a holy city, a city in whom the Lord Himself is temple and light. We are functioning like an avalanche of eternal realities in one person.

The tree of life is in the holy city, in the middle of the street of the city. It seems to me that the tree of life can figuratively speak of our souls, and the holy city can figuratively speak of our bodies. She is our spiritual mother above (*Galatians 4:26-27*). We are supernatural and spiritual children of Zion, having the Lord's glory on our bodies. So then, our share in the tree of life is our

deep soul transformation today, and our share in the holy city is our deep physical transformation today. Both of this soul and physical transformation are spiritual, because they come from beholding Jesus and having Him as our light.

Essentially, Jesus is telling us, “*come and take*”. There are many spiritual experiences that Jesus wants us to partake of in our souls and in our bodies. After commissioning John to write His words to the seven churches (*Revelation 2-3*), Jesus told John to “**Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this.**” Revelation 4:1. Jesus wanted John’s soul to participate in some of this spiritual realities and experiences, this is why Jesus signified the revelation by an angel and by visions.

I believe one of the reasons Jesus started by giving John prophetic light for the churches is so that they can repent and be in the position that John’s soul was now in, so that they can all journey into the visions of God and the realms of Zion, through God. For different churches, and different believers, there are different operations of the law of sin and death in the soul, that makes the soul heavy, and prevents the soul from the needed lightness to ascend and run that race that’s set before them (*Hebrews 12:1-*

2). The way to run this race is to look to Jesus, and hear Him say to us “come and see and share”! When we see and hear Jesus in the Spirit, and by the Spirit, substance enters our souls. It’s this spiritual substance that we call faith. Faith is the substance of what is hoped for, the evidence of the unseen (*Hebrews 11:1*). It’s the spiritual experiences of Zion in our souls that is the faith. Every scripture has a counterpart in Zion (*Daniel 10:21, Revelation 5:1*). Every Scripture is a capturing of experiences of Zion, which comes from God and flows out of heaven. This scroll is in the hands of God Himself, because it was written and sealed by Him for us I believe. The reflection of this scroll is what the Bible is. That’s why we say the Bible is inspired by God (*2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:21, John 10:35*). That’s what it means. This is also why the whole Scripture has one message, that message is God, Christ and His kingdom.

The first place that John experiences was the throne of God, and the reign of God. The person and Will of God became clearer to John. Then, John experiences the government of God, the ruling council around the throne of God. He saw the living creatures around the

throne of God, who were praise and worship leaders. These ones are joining God to say “Come”! They call others to worship God because of the majesty of God they beheld constantly. **“And whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne, saying, “Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.”** Revelation 4:9-11.

Then, John saw the sealed scroll in the right hand of God, which I believe is like a map to guide people to the tree of life and the holy city of God. It's a spiritual map, for the soul of man, and the body of man to journey until it arrives at the tree of life, so that it can partake of it, and therefore be useful in the holy city in worship and service to God.

Hallelujah, there's a scroll into the knowledge of God, the things of God and the destiny of mankind. God has revealed all things already, He has prepared them to be shared, only that they are sealed for us, and not from us.

He has done this because of the evil one. It will only be taken completely by the one who has completely defeated Satan, and John started to weep, because he could see that no one can find the tree of life and the holy city, without the map, and no one can open this sealed map without being completely righteous and holy, leaving no room for the enemy to usurp the entirety of the map. This is the knowledge of incorruptible and eternal life.

One of the elders around God's throne tells John to stop crying. **“And one of the elders said to me, “Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, *has conquered*, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals.”** Revelation 5:5, I believe this elder has jurisdiction in Isreal or the line of David. The elder did the work that John the Baptist did, which was to introduce the man Jesus. The man of war, who conquered Satan on the cross, preserving Himself. Because of His own righteousness, He can open the scroll and its seven seals. Jesus was introduced as a Lion, but when we would see Him through the eyes of John, we see a Lamb, standing with divine authority and divine fire-power. Now, Jesus reveals Himself to

John as the God-man, to whom all judgement has been handed (*John 5:22-24*).

When the Lamb starts opening the seals, we see that He begins to release prophetic judgements on evil, and on carnality, so that the way can be prepared for His coming. The living creatures are saying "Come"! They are saying "Come" by the protocols of Christ's reign and rule (*Revelation 6-7*). As prophesied in **Haggai 2**, everything in the heavens and in the earth are going to be shaken, and in fact, are being shaken, and as these things are being shaken, everything that can be shaken are being shaken (*Hebrews 12:27*). Another operation of divine judgement happening is the sealing of the elect of God. Those who have enlisted themselves in the army of God, as the bride, the elect, the overcomers, the remnant and the servants of God. Those engaging in warfare. These ones are being confirmed and being sealed. Hallelujah. While some are saying there's a casting down, others will be saying there's a lifting up. As chaos is increasing in the world, supernatural stability will be increasing in the saints. This is what is prophesied about in **Isaiah 60**.

"Then I saw another angel ascending from the rising of the sun, with the seal of the living God, and he

called with a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm earth and sea, saying, “Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.” And I heard the number of the sealed, 144,000, sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:” Revelation 7:2-4. This spiritual tribe of Israel are those with priesthood and kingship. These ones are being confirmed and being sealed. They are learning the covenant and possessing the seal of the living God. That’s another thing going on right now. The people of Zion are being confirmed.

After this, John’s eyes was open to see the great cloud of witnesses that are already rejoicing. The great harvest of the Lord (*Revelation 7:9-17*). These are the ones who have fought and have come out of the great tribulation. They fought with the blood of the Lamb, and are wearing a white robe. They are presently with Jesus, and He is guiding them by the Holy Spirit to life eternally. I believe these are the spirits of just men made perfect. These ones have gone to be with the Lord before the end of this age. Possibly the “saints” that Jesus will come with at His second coming as

recorded in **1 Thessalonians 3:13**.

Now, when we read **Revelation 8:1-5**, it becomes clearer to us that the opening of the seals was like the protocol following the high priest going into the most holy place, so that others can come. They're coming to the Lord, is the soul journeying from the outer courts to the most holy place, as signified by the tabernacle of Moses. This is the imagery of putting off flesh and sin, and possessing divinity in the soul. This is putting on immortality. **"When the Lamb opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. Then I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them. And another angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and he was given much incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar before the throne, and the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, rose before God from the hand of the angel. Then the angel took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake."** Revelation 8:1-5. With this revelations in John's soul, his soul was being patterned in a particular

way. There's was silence in heaven to mark the mystery of God. The place of perfect rest, and victory. Which shows us that victory is perfect rest, and it's God Himself.

We also see the connection of our prayers, and angelic activity, in mediating the reign of Christ. This revelation makes prayer deeply woven into our souls, so much so that we cannot live without prayer anymore. These ranking-angels who stand before the throne of God are given seven trumpets. They begin to sound the Will of God into the earth, causing a lot of supernatural manifestations and happenings. These angels work with those who have been praying and their prayers. Everyone in the school of revelation is a servant of God. This is why consecration leads us to higher revelation. Following Jesus positions us to be able to follow Him more. God is pleased with what Jesus is doing, as curated by angels. **"Then the angel took the censer and filled it with *fire from the altar and threw it on the earth, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake.*"** Revelation 8:5, this fire was generated from the sacrifice of the lamb, and it's been used to offer

fragrance to the Lord, and it's from this pleasure of the Lord that fire is communicated to the earth. What then is fire? It's the communication of the passionate and intense pleasure of God. This deep pleasure of God begins to overcome our souls and quiet our hearts. This is what the world is lacking (*1 John 2:15-17*). These seven angels are angels in the realm of fire, and they were communicating loud judgements against evil and carnality. In ***Revelation 8***, we see the things on earth shaken, and in ***Revelation 9***, at the blowing of the last three trumpets, we see under the earth shaken. These shakings are intense and they are the tree woes, of the last tree trumpet blasts.

At the first woe, the Destroyer was released with his army, and they came to battle in the air, causing great torment against evil and carnality. The only people that they didn't attack were those sealed by God. At the second woe, another terrible army came, and they killed a third of those who lived on earth, but guess what? ***"The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands nor give up worshipping demons and idols of gold and silver and bronze and stone and wood, which cannot see or hear or walk, nor did they repent of their murders or their***

sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.”

Revelation 9:20-21. The point of all these judgements, and the revelation of the judgements, is so that men wouldn't have to spend eternity in the lake of fire, the second death, but they will taste the real effect of their sins and the real wages of sin, and turn to the Lord Jesus for help. The hold of worldliness was so strong on these souls, that they couldn't repent.

When we get to **Revelation 10**, we see a most interesting vision of a mighty angel that looks to me like the Lord Jesus in manifestation as a man of covenant and glory. We see him coming in the capacity of the covenant of God with mankind. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Adamic covenant, the Noah covenant, the Abrahamic covenant, the Davidic covenant, Himself being the one that ratified the messianic covenant. He is the man that has the opened scroll of God, and by His roar, thunders fully (*Revelation 10:3*), which is an eternal counsel that reveals the full mystery of God to John, of which John wasn't permitted to write it down, just like Paul wasn't permitted to write down certain things (*2 Corinthians 12:6*). This 'mighty angel' **“swore by him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and what is**

in it, the earth and what is in it, and the sea and what is in it, *that there would be no more delay*, but that in the days of the trumpet call to be sounded by the seventh angel, *the mystery of God would be fulfilled*, just as he announced to his servants the prophets” Revelation 10:6-7. Again, Jesus came the first time to deal with sins, but when He is coming again, He is coming to save those waiting for Him (*Hebrews 9:28*). What will he save us from? From the world and from Satan’s assaults in this last battle.

The mighty angel gave John the little scroll to eat, and start to prophesy the content of this scroll, revealing what will happen to many peoples, nations, languages and kings. This scroll will be sweet to the mouth, which I believe insinuates that it will be liberating to his own soul, but then, bitter in his stomach which I believe means that the burden of the Lord will be heavy on John and the prophets of the last day because of everything that will happen to people. They wouldn’t be flippant with prophecy of judgement because they know the heart of the Father for all mankind.

John was commissioned to prophesy, after witnessing the unveiling of the seals and the trumpets by Jesus Christ.

Then, John was taught special discernment by the Spirit. He was given a measuring rod, to measure the temple of God, the altar, and the people therein, but he wasn't to measure the holy city, the outer courts. This spiritual discernment is about realizing what's changing and what will remain. That's what discernment is all about. It's the wisdom of God, for the transitions of dispensations and administrations. At this time, God is doing away with dead religion, and He is instituting His kingdom, and the oneness and reality of His kingdom.

At this time, God will release His two witnesses. **“And I will *grant authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth.”** **These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth. And if anyone would harm them, fire pours from their mouth and consumes their foes. If anyone would harm them, this is how he is doomed to be killed.”** Revelation 11:3-5, these two witnesses are described as olive trees because they are carriers of full measures of the anointing, and they are described as two lampstands because they are carriers of manifold light and revelation. They will be elevated for

serious warfare, just like Elijah and Moses were. They will reign in the earth, judging unrighteousness fiercely. They will even die and resurrect to exemplify the Lord, after which God will call them up to heaven. **“Then they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, “Come up here!” And they went up to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies watched them. And at that hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. Seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and *the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven.*”** Revelation 11:12-13, the witnesses were successful in that people’s pride were leveled a little. People gave glory to God. This is the second woe.

And then, at the blast of the seventh Trumpet, the mystery of God was fulfilled. The kingdoms of the world were turned to the kingdom of our God, not by the submission of the world but by the dominion of God. God took his great power and begun to reign. This kingdoms of this world becoming the kingdom of God is marked by some things. (a) God reigning with His great power, (b) the dead being judged (c) the rewarding of the prophets, servants and saints of God, (d) the destroying of the destroyers of the earth.

“Then God’s temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple. There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail.” Revelation 11:19. The veils were taken away, and God’s ark of the covenant was seen within the temple. When we see this, the soul realizes something. We realize the throne of God, and the seat of God’s authority, that it’s within, not outside. This is when we learn the inward life very deeply. This is when we learn the experiential meaning of life in the Spirit, and life in the covenant, not only the doctrine of it. This is when we see that the ark of the covenant is really a judgement of God in Christ Jesus. The glory of God is seen in the face of Jesus Christ, and through the unveiling of Jesus Christ. This revelation is what enables us for even a more effective spiritual warfare against the lies of the enemy.

The next scenes we see is that of warfare. We see the spiritual warfare over Isreal. Paul, in speaking of the judgement of God, puts Isreal first and then the gentiles. **“He will render to each one according to his works: to those who by patience in well-doing**

seek for glory and honor and immortality, he will give eternal life; but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury. There will be tribulation and distress for every human being who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek, but glory and honor and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek. For God shows no partiality.” Romans 2:6-10. We see that the Jews are God’s firstborn in the world, because of the promises to their fathers, and then the gentiles. We see this same tone in Revelation.

When we see the kingdom spiritual warfare in ***Revelation 12***, we read of a woman who is clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars, as though representing the tribes of Isreal. This woman looks to me like the kingdom of Isreal. The very first kingdom introduced to us in this warfare. She was pregnant and crying out in birth pains and the agony of giving birth. This is because Isreal is pregnant in the last days to produce many believers (*Romans 11:25*). **The dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she bore her child he might devour it.** That’s the demonic onslaught

against Isreal, our earthly mother, because Zion is our heavenly mother (*Galatians 4:26*). **She gave birth to a male child, one who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron, but her child was caught up to God and to his throne, and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, in which she is to be nourished for 1,260 days.** There's a generation of last day believers that will come from Isreal who will be mighty for God. In the same way that God protected Isreal when they were delivered from Egypt in the wilderness, God will also preserve this last day Isreal in the wilderness. Perhaps, this preservation is the "future temple" spoken at the end of Ezekiel or not. God will preserve the kingdom of Isreal, until the coming of Jesus Christ (*Romans 11:26-29*).

"Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back, but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown

down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, ***“Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God.”*** Revelation 12:7-10, this is the war spoken about by Daniel, when he said ***“At that time shall arise Michael, the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time. But at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky above; and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever. But you, Daniel, shut up the words and seal the book, until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase.”*** Daniel 12:1-4. Michael is the warring archangel over Isreal, and he fought with Satan over Isreal I believe, and those who put faith in Jesus, shall be delivered from the

oppression of Satan through accusations before God. The Jewish saints in heaven rejoice because Satan has been overcome. The Jewish saints on earth have overcome him through their warfare and prayers. They have overcome him by the blood of the lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death (*Revelation 12:11*). This means that they gave themselves fully to spiritual warfare against the kingdom of darkness, spirit, soul and body. They believed, they prayed and they suffered. Their convictions were solid in full consecration. Irrespective of all the knowledge of the time, they stayed in faith and dedication to the Lord. These are the ones who will be martyrs, and servants of God in the great tribulation. They do deep warfare to preserve a generation of overcomers. During Jesus' time, Anna and Simeon prayed until the coming of Jesus.

“Therefore, rejoice, O heavens and you who dwell in them! But woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!” Revelation 12:12, believers are citizens of heaven also, and they will rejoice over this victory, and as believers advance, Satan intensifies his onslaught on non-believers to

make them apostates since he knows that his time is short.

In spiritual warfare, for every victory we record, Satan attempts to retaliate with more wickedness. We have to know this. Because Satan had been cast down, losing authority over Isreal in the realms of the spirit, he got angry and started pursuing the woman, the kingdom of Isreal, making serious war with her. God preserved this kingdom of Isreal sovereignly by giving her two wings of the eagle to fly. This speaks of prophetic power deliverances. And not only that, when the dragon released water from its mouth for the purpose of flooding the woman, **the earth came to the help of the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed the river that the dragon had poured from his mouth. *Then the dragon became furious with the woman and went off to make war on the rest of her offspring, on those who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus. And he stood on the sand of the sea.*** Since the dragon cannot make war against the man child that has been caught up to the throne of God, he makes war on the rest of her offspring. These are the servants of God and followers of Jesus.

Satan stood on the sand of the sea. This seems to me like beneath the sea. This seems to me like the systems of the earth. The kingdoms of this world. He operates marine spirits, and all kinds of false spirits, to put strongholds in place, to manipulate emotions. He tries to influence people through manipulating emotions, since he cannot win by truth. He wars by deception. Our greatest weapon against Satan and darkness is truth; both personal truth and systemic truth. The rest of the offspring of this woman is the church of Jesus Christ.

So then, this deceptive strategy of Satan, is used by giving his authority to his own antichrist system and kingdom, and also his antichrist man. Satan hides behind worldliness and behind false prophet(s). This is how he perpetuates his kingdom, making himself into an angel of light. That's deception and that's knowledge. The increase of knowledge is due to the activity of Satan, but though knowledge is increasing, wisdom is decreasing in the systems of this world. This deception is what James called demonic wisdom. Satan makes the world and the opinion of men look so great because these opinions are held up by political

powers, economic powers, social powers, increasing through educational powers and knowledge. With the break out of internet, and AI, there's so much knowledge, and so much pride of life being developed, so that many will be distracted by the acquisition of a place in this world, and through spending all their time to pursue this, they do not pursue the reign of God's kingdom in this world. This is Satan's strategy against the kingdom of Jews, and the kingdom of the church.

When we read ***Revelation 13***, we would see the antichrist system that Satan is running. It's described as a beast. It's **"a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads, with ten diadems on its horns and blasphemous names on its heads."** Revelation 13:1, it's a system of governance or dominion, with different players, connected unrighteously and by unrighteousness. It appears to have victory, and it opposes God. It deceives those whose names aren't captured in Zion. **"Also it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it over every tribe and people and language and nation, and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the**

book of life of the Lamb who was slain.” Revelation 13:7-8.

The antichrist system will cause persecution against the physical bodies of saints, yet, it wouldn't be able to deceive them. This is because they trust in the power of God for much endurance and supernatural deliverance.

“Then I saw another beast rising out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon. It exercises all the authority of the first beast in its presence, and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose mortal wound was healed. It performs great signs, even making fire come down from heaven to earth in front of people, and by the signs that it is allowed to work in the presence of the beast it deceives those who dwell on earth, telling them to make an image for the beast that was wounded by the sword and yet lived.” Revelation 13:11-14, this is the human antichrist, not only the system. This human antichrist walks and works with the antichrist authority and powers, causing fire to come down from heaven to earth in front of people. Its goal is to get people to

make an image for the beast, and the antichrist kingdom. What's an image? A visible representation of that antichrist system. This is the antichrist agenda, and this is what we are called to demolish by Christ.

“And it was allowed to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast might even speak and might cause those who would not worship the image of the beast to be slain. Also it causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, to be marked on the right hand or the forehead, so that no one can buy or sell unless he has the mark, that is, the name of the beast or the number of its name.” Revelation 13:15-17. This seems to me like a machine being made, an image, and being given breath so that it would be able to speak and warfare. The economic systems of the world will be run by machines and artificial intelligence, which are demonized, and empowered to fight righteousness. They will cause people to receive the mark of the beast of the number of its name. This mark of the beast is something that will be in the bodies of those who reject Christ, being positioned to oppose the divine order and righteousness of God. It can be a trade-mark, or a vaccine, or a pin-code

or a genetic modification or gender reorientation or any of these kinds of things.

“Then I looked, and behold, on Mount Zion stood the Lamb, and with him 144,000 who had his name and his Father’s name written on their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven like the roar of many waters and like the sound of loud thunder. The voice I heard was like the sound of harpists playing on their harps, and they were singing a *new song* before the throne and before the four living creatures and before the elders. No one could learn that song except the 144,000 who had been redeemed from the earth. It is these who have not defiled themselves with women, for they are virgins. It is these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes.” Revelation 14:1-4,

While Satan is trying to mark people, bullying them with economics, God is marking people with His anointing. This anointing teaches them a new song, a new intimacy, something that cannot be learnt from anyone but from the Lord. This is what marks the remnant. This anointing teaches these bridal company purity, both spiritual purity and sexual purity. These ones are

also passionate and willing vessels. Following the lamb wherever. We are such in the name of Jesus.

So then, after the seventh Trumpet was blown, having seen the kingdom of darkness in warfare with the kingdom of Israel and the church, having seen the kingdom of darkness with its false trinity, namely, Satan, the antichrist kingdom, and the antichrist man, having seen the bride of Christ and the Lamp anointed in Zion, having seen the angels announcing the hour of judgement, which is called a Gospel, the Gospel of the kingdom, saying that Babylon has been judged. **“Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who made all nations drink the wine of the passion of her sexual immorality.”** Revelation 14:8. Showing us that the Gospel of the kingdom is to be preached to the whole world, and it’s about the coming judgement on that unrepentant world. Another angel said **“If anyone worships the beast and its image and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand, he also will drink the wine of God’s wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.”** Revelation 14:9-10. That is, those who rejected Christ will

have to suffer the consequences of this. In the process of this, many saints will have to persevere and endure through it all.

It's after this that Jesus comes as the Lord of the harvest, who reaped the whole earth in a wheat harvest, and then, another angel came to reap the grape harvest of wrath (*Revelation 14:14-20*). **“Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and amazing, seven angels with seven plagues, which are the last, for with them the wrath of God is finished.”** Revelation 15:1. These seven plagues are an extension of the seventh trumpet. Then, it seems to me that those who were harvested in the wheat harvest from the earth, are now singing a new song as they are ascending to Zion. They sang the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb (*Revelation 15:2-4*). It appears to me that this is the rapture or the catching away, based on the appearance of the Lord of the harvest. The Lord of the harvest is the one coming to receive His harvest, which is the result of the seed He had sown through His death and resurrection. He is coming to reap His fruits. After this, then, there's the pouring of the seven bowls of wrath (*Revelation 16*).

These seven bowls of wrath had to do with seven

plagues. These plagues are health issues. They are things that will affect the body. It's almost as if judgement had come on the spirits, on the souls and on the bodies of the unrighteous people. When judgment comes on spirit, there's spiritual death and burden. It's a call to show loss of glory, so that the soul can be renewed, and not be judged, but when this one too is judged, then, the body must be judgment too. Perhaps, this is why the judgement of the seven plagues is tied to the seven trumpets.

These final seven bowls of wrath was also poured on all dimensions. It was poured on the earth, on the sea, on the waters, on the sun, on the throne of the beast, on the great river Euphrates, and the air. The seven bowls were poured on all the forces, I believe, that the inhabited world revolves around, and these different dimensions resisted the unrepentant people, showing them the fruit of their sin, and this spiritual death was evidenced by torment, pain and deep rebellion. When **“The fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness. People gnawed their tongues in anguish and cursed the God of heaven for their pain and sores. They did not repent of their deeds.”** Revelation 16:10-11. Now, the

throne of the beast masquerades itself like a throne of light, advancement and innovation. It's the nature of sin and unrighteousness, but as soon as the judgement comes on the throne, its kingdom and influence and reign was plunged into darkness. Satan disguises himself as an angel of light, but he will be revealed to be the most wicked. Even though people would see the wickedness of sin and Satan, they wouldn't be able to repent because they are already apostates. They've already been recruited by Satan for his enterprise, and they will be motivated by anger and rebellion and hurt against God to fight this last battle. They will be empowered with three unclean spirits like frogs which came through evil impartation from **the mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet**, performing signs, going abroad to the kings of the whole world, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God the Almighty (*Revelation 16:14*). This is a battle that Jesus Christ is coming to fight as the King of kings, and the Lord of lords, who is called the Word of God. This is the spiritual-mortal combat that is going to be fought when the seventh angel pour out his bowl into the air.

When this seventh bowl of wrath was emptied; **“a loud voice came out of the temple, from the throne, saying, *“It is done!”* And there were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, and a great earthquake such as there had never been since man was on the earth, so great was that earthquake. The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell, and God remembered Babylon the great, to make her drain the cup of the wine of the fury of his wrath”** Revelation 16:17-18.

This great battle begins with the announcement of victory! Hallelujah. This kind of battle begins with victory. It begins with it is done. That’s why we go into warfare with thanksgiving. That’s how to fight. After the proclamation of victory, then, there were shakings, heavenly and earthly shakings. Immediately, like Jericho that was split, Babylon, the great city split into three parts and the cities of the nations also fell. That’s the whole system of worldliness crumbling.

In ***Revelation 17***, we see the great judgement of the great city, the great prostitute, Babylon, the mother of prostitutes and of earth’s abominations. This woman was the world power because she was sitting on the
